DO'S and DON'TS for Interactions with Street Dogs



DO'S

- Stay calm if a dog approaches
- Maintain distance from dog groups
- Inform authorities in case of aggressive behavior
- Use designated areas for feeding, if applicable
- Show compassion and respect from a distance



DON'TS

- Do not tease or provoke dogs
- Avoid feeding dogs near classrooms and hostels
- Do not run or make sudden movements
- Do not approach dogs when they are eating or sleeping
- Do not disturb dogs with puppies
